

HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

The district makes provisions for homebound instruction upon referral from the District Physician or the Assistant Superintendent following the guidelines established by the Superintendent of Schools for placing a student on homebound instruction.

Homebound instruction is a service provided to students who are (1) unable to attend school due to medical, emotional or disciplinary problems for more than ten consecutive days, or (2) found by the Committee on Special Education to require such services. Students receiving this service shall receive instruction for one hour per day.
