ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

The Board of Education establishes that residence, for the purpose of school attendance, is presumed to be in that school district in which parents or legal guardians reside.

Non-resident pupils shall be excluded from the schools of the district, with the following exceptions:

1. a non-resident child whose family is planning to move into the district within fifty days of the first day of classes may be accepted at the beginning of the school year by the administration if parent/guardian has provided satisfactory proof they will be residing within the district within fifty days of the first day of classes.
2. children of families moving out of the district with fifty school days or less remaining before the last day of classes in the school year may continue for the remainder of the school year;

The exceptions listed above shall not be made unless:

- a. room is available;
- b. parents provide transportation

There will be no discrimination on the basis of race, creed, sex, disability or color.

The district of residence of non-resident students with disabilities may apply to North Bellmore for placement of the student in the North Bellmore district. If North Bellmore determines that it has an appropriate program and space is available, North Bellmore may accept the student and the district of residence shall be responsible for payment of tuition and transportation.
