MINUTES OF THE NORTH BELLMORE UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING August 27, 2013

A special meeting of the North Bellmore Union Free School District Board of Education was held on Tuesday evening, August 27, 2013, in the Board Room at the Martin Avenue School.

The meeting was called to order at 8:22 p.m. by Board of Education President, Nina Lanci. Mrs. Testa led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Mayo read the District's mission statement.

Mr. Jerry Marino, North Bellmore North Merrick Little League, and Mrs. Lashin and Mrs. Cerati, Saw Mill PTA, made a presentation to the Board on improvements to Saw Mill Road School that could be accomplished by utilizing a grant from Leg. David Denenberg in the total amount of \$80,000.

Mr. Marino spoke about the following upgrades that the Little League would like to make:

- Install new handicap parking lot
- Install new drywell by the parking lot
- Make the dugouts concrete
- Install French drains behind the dugouts
- Re-grade the fields
- Install sprinklers on the North field

Mrs. Lashin shared a proposal for additional playground equipment suitable for grades K-6.

Mrs. Lanci thanked the Little League and the Saw Mill PTA for bringing the information forward.

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Mr. Schissler indicated to the Board that in order to proceed with the legislative grant, the district needs to approve the SEQRA resolution that was tabled at the August board meeting, agenda item No. 14.5.

Motion was made by Mr. Ferrara, seconded by Mr. Mayo to reinstate the SEQRA resolution that was tabled at the August 8, 2013 Board of Education meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Motion was made by Mr. Ferrara, seconded by Mr. Mayo, to approve the following resolution. Motion carried 5-0.

State Environment Quality Review Notice of Determination of Non-Significance

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the **NORTH BELLMORE UFSD** is the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Process for the purpose of required determinations respecting the proposed Capital Improvement Projects as follows:

INSTALLATION OF A SPRINKLER SYSTEM FOR THE BASEBALL FIELD, INSTALL A PLAYGROUND AND CONSTRUCT A HANDICAPPED PARKING LOT AT THE SAW MILL ROAD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, in 1995, amendments were made to the SEQRA Regulation (Part 617) to classify projects, which will be excluded from the requirements for the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (Type II Actions). The projects mentioned above are (is) now classified as Type II Actions as determined by 6NYCRR§617.5 and

WHEREAS, this project falls under the following categories:

- A. Routine Maintenance and Repair 6NYCRR§617.5 (c)(1): Maintenance or repair involving no substantial change in an existing facility.
- B. Replacement or Rehabilitation 6NYCRR§617.5 (c)(2): replacement or rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, unless the work exceeds a threshold for a Type I action in 6NYCRR§617.4.

THEREFORE, as the lead agency for the SEQRA determination, the above referenced project falls under Categories "A" or "B" above. The procedure for Type II Actions, with regard to the SEQRA Process for Capital Projects noted above is "<u>No Additional Required Action under 6NYCRR§617.5(a)</u>".

On a motion by Mrs. DeLauter, seconded by Mrs. Cramsie, and carried 5-0, the Board of Education agreed to enter Executive Session to discuss a particular Personnel matter at 9:07p.m.
